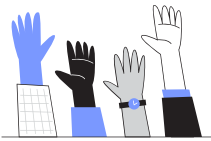


Nonviolent Communication through Interactive Scenarios

TIMING of ACTIVITY



60 minutes

OBJECTIVE(S)



- Develop skills to craft empathetic and supportive messages
- Enhance real-time communication and conflict-resolution abilities
- Receive and apply critical feedback to improve communication skills

DESCRIPTION



- **Preparation:** Create a chatbot with SchoolAI. Write clear and concise prompt with short, understandable sentences. Include relevant background information, the more context you provide, the better the chatbot responses will be.
- **Introduction** (10 minutes)
Briefly introduce the concept of NVC and its importance in fostering empathetic dialogue.
Explain the structure of the activity and the role of the chatbot.
- **Interactive Scenarios** (35 minutes)
Scenario Presentation: The chatbot presents various real-life scenarios where students must respond using NVC principles.
Real-Time Response: Students craft their responses in real time, focusing on observations, feelings, needs, and requests.
Critical Feedback: The chatbot provides immediate feedback on their responses, highlighting strengths and areas for improvement.
- **Group Discussion** (10 minutes)

Students share their experiences and discuss the feedback received.

Encourage reflection on how their communication style has evolved.

- **Wrap-Up and Q&A** (5 minutes)
Summarize key takeaways from the session.
Open the floor for any questions or additional comments.

ASSESSMENT & FEEDBACK



- Formative Assessment: Continuous feedback from the chatbot on each scenario response.
- Peer Review: Students review each other's responses and provide constructive feedback.
- Self-Reflection: Students can maintain a journal to reflect on their progress and areas for improvement.

TIPS & RESOURCES



- Encourage students to be open and honest in their responses.
- Foster a supportive environment where students feel safe to express themselves.
- Use role-playing to make scenarios more engaging and realistic.
